Dear Parents/Carers,

I am writing to inform you about the upcoming assessment period and the schedule for your young person's assessments at Alloa Academy which take place from Monday 12th January to Friday 23rd January inclusive. During this time, we have planned the following arrangements for your young person's convenience and academic support.

- Young people should follow their normal timetables at all times during the assessment period with the following exceptions detailed below.
- On the day of the assessment, if young people have an assessment scheduled in the morning, they will be free to go home in the afternoon. If any young person has an assessment scheduled in the afternoon, there will be no need for them to come into school in the morning.
- Young people who receive Alternative Assessment Arrangements (AAA) will have their timetables distributed separately by Ms Reid.
- All young people will receive Individual copies of their timetable on Tuesday 16th December. In case of any concerns or discrepancies regarding the levels listed, please contact Mr. Kirkpatrick for assistance.

Please note that our teaching staff will **not** be covering new material during this period. Young people should follow their normal timetable where staff will support their revision and provide an opportunity to catch up on any coursework or assignments.

We believe that this approach will provide the young people of Alloa Academy with the necessary support to excel in their assessments and ensure they are well-prepared for their final exams.
