Dear Parents/Carers,

I am writing to inform you about the upcoming SQA exam period with the schedule and support for your young person's exams at Alloa Academy. During this time, we have planned the following arrangements for your young person's convenience and academic support.

On the day of the exam, if young people have an exam scheduled in the morning, they will be free to go home in the afternoon. If any young person has an exam scheduled in the afternoon, there will be no need for them to come into school in the morning. However, if they do plan to come to school, they should sign in and out at the school office.

Young people will receive their exam timetables on the week of 25th March. They should check each subject and level over the Easter break. Young people will receive their final timetable on the week beginning 15th April.
